SCHOLARSHIPS awarded by Senior Schools to Year 8 leavers:

1 Academic (Framlingham), 1 Art (Gresham's) and 1 Sports (Framlingham)

The remaining Year 8 leavers have all gained places at their first choice Senior School.

In CE:

91% of pupils scored A to C grades across all subjects

50 % of pupils scored A to B grades across all subjects

UK Mathematics Trust Junior Maths Challenge.

This is a national competition and is open to all children in the UK.

Taverham Hall School achieved:

1 gold award – this pupil was in the top 6% of results

3 silver awards and

6 bronze awards

PRE PREP DEPARTMENT - In the KS1 SATS

95% of pupils scored level 2b 2a and level 3 in reading

85% of pupils scored level 2b 2a and level 3 in writing

95% of pupils scored level 2b 2a and level 3 in maths

The nationally expected level at Key Stage 1 is level 2 with level 3 proving to be increasingly hard to obtain.

This year's Year 2 had 65% of pupils achieving level 3 in their Reading assessment.



NURSERY DEPARTMENT

MUSIC results

99% pass rate in the Associated Board of the Royal school of Music's Practical Examinations with many pupils gaining merit and distinction awards

Over 100 pupils received extra-curricular music tuition per week.

29 music assemblies took place this academic year, with music ranging from original pupil compositions to rock music and classical items

22 pupils performed at the Norfolk County Music Festival

Our Chapel Choir seniors sang six items in the Norfolk Young Musicians' Concert

National Junior EURO Language Challenge Competition results

This is a national competition and is open to all children aged up to 11 years old in the UK.

4 pupils qualified for the semi-finals having learned Italian.

These 4 pupils then had to learn Japanese over the summer holiday period and competed for a place in the finals. All 4 pupils finished in the top 20 out of 39 regional semi-finalists with 1 of them finishing in second place.

This 1 pupil qualified for the final which took place in London in October 2010 and finished 15th out of the 40 finalists having had to learn Chichewa in less than a month.

ART

Under the sea – National Artwork Competition: 12 Taverham Hall School pupils received notification that they have had art work on the theme of 'Under the Sea' published.

ENGLISH
