1995:

Long Jump - 3rd English Schools. Ranked #1 in UK at Under 17 with 7.00m.

Octathlon - 1st English Schools. Ranked #1 in UK at Under 17 with 5423 points (also British Record).

Triple Jump - Ranked #5 in UK at under 17 with 13.79m.

1996:

Decathlon - Competed in first Junior International in Narbonne, France. 6617 points. Highest Decathlon score by 17 year old since Daley Thompson.

1997:

110mH - 1st English Schools. Ranked #1 in UK at Under 20 with 14.07s.

1998 - Present Day: Competed at various meetings around the World for the Senior England and GB team.

Currently in training for 2012 Olympics and European Championships.
