**Hidato Puzzle 4**

Like Sudoku, Hidato features easy-to-follow rules combined with increasingly difficult puzzles. The goal is to fill in the grid with consecutive numbers that connect horizontally, vertically or diagonally. They can be solved using 100% logic. No guesswork is needed, and no mathematics are required
