Pupils will undertake BCU Paddlepower Start—an entry-level award suitable as an introduction to paddlesport and progress on to Paddlepower Passport progressive levels based on 24 topics (grouped into Safety Awareness, Paddling Skills, Varied Experiences and Supporting Knowledge). The scheme provides progression and rewards achievement in a wide range of topics. This course includes lots of fun and exciting games as well as the opportunity to get wet!

Senior Clay Pigeon Shooting Club with Mr Hoare Y6 to Y8

Clay pigeon shooting, also known as clay target shooting, is the art of shooting a firearm at special flying targets, known as clay pigeons or clay targets. Set in an attractive woodland setting, the Mid Norfolk Shooting School is widely recognised as an outstanding facility to sharpen shooting skills and take lessons from an expert instructor at a ratio of 1:7. Transport to and from the Shooting School will be provided in addition to gun hire and a minimum of 20 clays and cartridges for your use in each session. Gun storage can be arranged by contacting the Mid Norfolk Shooting Range directly. Please note this may incur an additional cost.

Whilst this hobby is open to Year 6, due to the nature of the sport and the weight of the guns, Year 6 children must have prior experience and be able to handle a 28-gauge shot gun independently. Mr Hoare will be happy to discuss this and assess it on an individual basis and has kindly asked that Year 6 parents interested in this hobby contact him directly at t.hoare@taverhamhall.co.uk
